PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Hello everyone,

We have seen our first snow fall and falling temperatures over the past week. Please take time to ensure your child has the appropriate clothing for outdoor recess. The value of outdoor play is important to us and we only have indoor recess when it is colder than -22C or if it is raining. It is also helpful for you child and our staff if you help your child to learn how to get dressed for the weather. Zipping up jackets, putting on winter boots and mitts can all present challenges if a child has not had time to practice. This will help them feel more comfortable at school and build independence.

Every spring we send home a parent survey to get feedback about how we are meeting the needs for your child. We always take the time to go over the data and use it to guide our work with students and our community. As a school team, we are working diligently to support all our students' learning needs. Our grade teams, administration, and outside specialists all work together to create and deliver programs that will help each student reach their potential. We are also excited to continue connecting with our parents through volunteer opportunities, assemblies, and school events.

Below are some highlights from last year's survey:

96.2% of families agree their child is receiving the academic support they need to be successful at school.

93.1% of our families agree their child's learning environment is welcoming, caring, respectful, and safe.

98.3% of families indicated that their child is connected to at least one adult at Jessie Duncan.

91.4 % of families indicated that they are satisfied with communication they receive from the school.


